- 1. State Law requires that children under 14 years of age must have adult supervision at all times.
- 2. Residents may invite 2 guests and must be present when their guests are utilizing the facilities.
- 3. No bicycles or pets are permitted in the facilities at any time.
- 4. Residents are responsible for any damages to the facilities caused or contributed to by their families or their guests.
- 5. Keys to the facilities may not be given or loaned to nonresidents, as they are to be only in the possession of the residents.
- 6. The swimming pool and spa areas are for the exclusive use of the residents of Galleria and their authorized guests.
- 7. No alcoholic beverage or beer allowed in the pool area.
- 8. No diving, horseplay of any kind, at any time, or any other activity which could cause injury is strictly forbidden.
- 9. Residents and their guests use the facilities at their own risk.
- 10. A lifeguard is not in attendance at any time so the Board or the Association will not be responsible or liable for accident, injury or death occurring within the pool confines.
- 11. Conduct and noise level must be considerate to adjoining residents.
- 12. Litter will be cleaned from the area by the responsible resident.
- 13. When others are waiting, spa use is limited to 20 minutes.

Abuse of these rules may result in a fine and suspension of recreational facility privileges

## Spa Safety

- 1. Elderly persons, pregnant women, infants and those with health care conditions requiring medical care should consult with a physician before entering a spa.
- 2. Unsupervised use by children under the age of 14 is prohibited.
- 3. Hot water immersion while under the influence of alcohol, narcotics, drugs or medicines may lead to serious consequences and is not recommended.
- 4. Do not use alone.
- Long exposure may result in nausea, dizziness, or fainting. No oils, eucalyptus, etc. may be put in the spa.
